Safeguarding Children from Abuse by Sexual Exploitation

Who is it for?

Any person who comes into contact with children during the course of their work.

Aim

This course will:

- ✓ Raise your awareness of the legislation and guidance that applies to vulnerable groups and how these policies can be applied in practice.
- ✓ Explain risk assessments and vulnerability factors and outlines the roles of various agencies such so you know what your responsibility is.

Objectives

By the end of the course you will:

- ✓ Have an awareness of the background to child sexual exploitation, including definitions, the key legislation and guidance and research findings.
- ✓ Understand the risk assessment process, including the elements of a good assessment.
- ✓ Know the categories of risk and what vulnerability factors to look for when undertaking an assessment.
- ✓ Have a basic knowledge of the responsibilities of the key agencies involved in helping children at risk of sexual exploitation.

Course Delivery

Safeguarding Children from Abuse by Sexual Exploitation is an e-learning course. This means that it is delivered via the internet on a computer in your workplace.

The course may take up to 2 hours in total to complete. However you can start and stop the learning to suit your workload.

Course Pre-Requisites

To be able to undertake the course in the workplace you will need access to a computer with internet access and a very basic knowledge of how to log on to a computer and access the internet.
